



COMING IN 2021

The Cape Town Chess Academy will commence chess training in January 2021. The Academy will provide professional chess training for beginner, intermediate, and advanced level players.

A structured chess curriculum will be followed for beginner level players whilst intermediate and advanced level players will follow an intensive group training programme based on the results of the development needs assessment conducted on individual players. The training programme will require a high level of commitment from participants as our training objective is that players must reach a pre-defined developmental outcome within a specified period.

Chess training will be conducted by a team of professional chess trainers under the direction of the Academy's Training Director, Mr Andrew Talmarkes. The training will be delivered through a hybrid system of contact sessions, video conferencing and remote learning support using smart devices. The enablement of the effective use of technology and online resources are an integral part of our training methodology. Contact training sessions in compliance with Covid-19 health protocols will be conducted at the Academy's training centre in Oakdale, Bellville.
